At the end of the previous year, which ran into the first quarter of 2021, there continued a wonderful cross cultural exhibition, "What Is Hanukkah?". This brought together the different faiths using the artwork as a platform to inquire and learn about the Jewish culture and religion. (https://www.artimpactinternational.org/what-is-hanukkah). All the artists were commended with Certificates of Participation. We utilized 10 online 3-D virtual gallery exhibition spaces to make these works accessible and convienient to everyone, no matter their location or time zone.
